UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Discussion with Road Commission over Norway Lake and LeValley Road problems left from KWA pipeline installation Destain Gingell and Joe Haack from the Road Commission were on hand to discuss the repairs needed on Norway Lake Road, Flint River Road and the other haul routes that KWA used for installing the pipeline. The Road Commission is entering into litigation over the problem areas and asked us to hold on until a judgement is rendered. KWA has settled with Oregon Township on problems with Stanley Road.

The Board reviewed the letter sent by Attorney Gildner in response to Mr. Valentine's letter regarding the petition forms for the zoning ordinance referendum. His position is that Election Law dictates that none of the signatures on the petitions are valid.

Hollis made a motion, supported by Glesenkamp to approve \$365.00 to allow our township residents to participate in the county wide hazardous waste collection for free.
